## Treatment Description:

S: Patient on vet check for geriatric exam including dermatological lesions, vision and hearing impair. Patient shivering throughout exam.

## O: PHYSICAL EXAM

HR: 150 Respiration: 30 CRT < 2sec BAR MM Pink BCS 4/9

EENT: Bilateral lenticular sclerosis/nuclear opacities OU. Mild dry ocular discharge w/tear staining. Ears and nose grossly clean. Limited oral exam: severe dental disease with multiple to complete tooth loss. Absent menace response OU w/ possibly intact PLRs OU. Hearing appears reduced by history/observation.

LN: no obvious lesions

Thorax: Eupneic with no increased respiratory effort. Soft systolic heart murmur ausculted possibly (approx Grade I/VI).

Abdomen: soft, non-painful, no obvious lesions noted

Genitourinary: clean, no discharge noted

Integument: Severely matted haircoat w/ flea dirt present. Generalized alopecia w/ diffuse erythema and hyperpigmentation affecting trunk and tail.

Musculoskeletal: amb x4, no lameness noted today. Hunched posture while ambulating in kennel. Thickening of the left stifle noted. Full orthopedic exam not performed.

Neuro: mentation appropriate, no gross deficits. Absent Menace response & positive PLR OU. Full neuro exam not performed.

## A:

- Generalized chronic dermatitis w/severe matting and evidence of flea infestation. - - Vision deficits: r/o age-related lenticular sclerosis; cataracts
- Suspected hearing impairment
- Marked tooth loss: r/o advanced periodontal disease
- Soft Grade I/VI systolic heart murmur: r/o degenerative valvular disease vs other cardiomyopathy
- Left stifle thickening consistent with chronic osteoarthritis or previous orthopedic injury.
- Shivering and hunched posture may reflect stress, pain, age-related discomfort, or difficulty thermoregulating.

## P:

- Apoquel (5.4 mg) 0.5 tabs PO SID x 14d
- Clavamox (62.5 mg) 1.25 tab PO BID x 14d
- Gabapentin (50 mg/ml) 0.60 ml PO SID x 7d
- Diet: Canned/soft food only (severe dental disease & missing teeth)
- Monitor daily for limping or worsening mobility associated with the thickened left stifle.
- Monitor for appetite, behavior and worsening condition and contact veterinarian if this occurs.

PERMANENT TRUST. DEFER in SHELTER. HEALTH WAIVER. Adopter should establish care with a primary veterinarian for comprehensive geriatric evaluation, diagnostics, treatment of chronic conditions, and alteration surgery if deemed an appropriate anesthetic candidate at the adopter's expense.
