Musculoskeletal: amb x4

Neuro: appropriate mentation, no gross deficits

A: Nasal discharge: CIRDC, other infectious disease, pulmonary disease, open

Monitor for appetite, behavior and worsening condition and contact veterinarian if this occurs. Feed canned food to entice appetite, if necessary. If this patient continues to show signs after 7 days, bring to veterinarian for refill of medication. The infection may take up to 3 weeks to clear. OK TO GO OUT ON TRUST- URI- RETURN 1 WEEK AFTER MEDICATION IS DONE AND SIGNS HAVE DISSIPATED. HEALTH WAIVER
