HR: uto Respiration: 40 CRT uto BAR MM Pink BCS uto

EENT: no ocular/nasal discharge during examination. No oral exam today.

Thorax: eupneic, no obvious signs of distress, n/e

Abdomen: n/e

Genitourinary: no obvious lesions/discharge noted

Integument: old lesions around face, bilateral pressure sores on dorsal carpus of TLs. LTL pressure sore > RTL. Remaining coat- full & appear clean.

Monitor for appetite, behavior and worsening condition and contact veterinarian if this occurs. Feed canned food to entice appetite, if necessary.

If this patient continues to show signs after 7 days, bring to veterinarian for refill of medication. The infection may take up to 3 weeks to clear.
