A dog's behavior may change based on surroundings, training, medical, socialization, and life experiences."

Mollie A5785666 was asleep when the runner approached his kennel, she slowly got up and greeted the runner with a relaxed demeanor, she was easy to remove, and she moderately pulled on leash. In the catch pen when she was introduced to the dog her body was neutral, her eyes were alert and her tail was low with no wag. She was easy to collar and leash. She entered the yard and began exploring. She was tense during her greetings. The handler had to use the spray bottle to move her away. She walked away and slowly roamed the yard. She tensed up with the dogs anytime they were near her. She kept to herself. Overall, Mollie was selective of the dogs and does not have a playstyle at this time. Behaviorally ok for public adoption, no large dogs recommended.
