Treatment Description:

S: P on vet check for geriatric status. Large mass noted over the left hip/proximal left hindlimb. P currently receiving carprofen (Vetprofen) and gabapentin per shelter protocol.

O: PHYSICAL EXAM

HR: 120 Respiration: 32 CRT < 2sec BAR MM Pink BCS 6/9

EENT: Eyes clear OU, ears grossly clean AU, nose clean. Mild to moderate dental calculus. Upper and lower canine teeth exhibit marked wear at the tips.

LN: no obvious lesions

Thorax: eupneic, no obvious signs of distress, no apparent murmurs/arrhythmias noted today

Abdomen: soft, non-painful, no obvious lesions noted

Genitourinary: clean, no discharge noted

Integument: Firm, dark, solitary cutaneous/subcutaneous mass measuring approximately 5–6 cm over the left hip/proximal left hindlimb. Mild alopecia present over the dorsal tail base.

Musculoskeletal: amb x4. Mild stiff gait with mild bilateral stifle thickening consistent with osteoarthritic change . Full ortho exam not performed.

Neuro: mentation appropriate, no gross deficits. Full neuro exam not performed.

A:

Geriatric patient.

Large (5–6 cm), firm cutaneous/subcutaneous mass over left hip/proximal left hindlimb: r/o neoplasia (benign or malignant) versus other soft tissue mass.

Mild osteoarthritis (stiff gait and stifle thickening)

Mild to moderate dental disease with worn canine teeth.

Mild dorsal tail alopecia,

P: OKAY to cont txt per SP

Monitor appetite, activity level, comfort, behavior, size/appearance of the left hindlimb mass. Notify veterinarian if decreased appetite, worsening lameness, rapid mass enlargement, ulceration, or other clinical concerns develop. Feed canned food to entice appetite, if necessary. TRUST.
