S: Patient on vet check for oral bleeding due to self trauma on leash, and alopecia of dorsum. Hx of quarantine. Growling as you approach the kennel.

O: PHYSICAL EXAM (limited)

HR: 120 Respiration: 32 CRT < 2sec BAR MM Pink BCS 4/9

EENT: Eyes clear/ no discharge. Mild alopecia periocular OU. Ears/ Nose grossly clean. No oral exam today.

LN: n/e

Thorax: eupneic, no obvious signs of distress. n/e

Abdomen: n/e

Genitourinary: clean, no discharge noted

Integument: Mild alopecia on caudal dorsal lumbar region & tail.

Musculoskeletal: amb x4, no lameness noted today. Full ortho exam not performed.

Neuro: mentation appropriate, no gross deficits. Full neuro exam not performed.

A:

- Mild alopecia on caudal dorsal lumbar region & tail: r/o flea allergy dermatitis, vs food/atopy allergy, vs. metabolic-related, vs. endocrine-related

P: OK to cont txt per SP

Monitor for appetite, behavior and worsening condition and contact veterinarian if this occurs. Feed canned food to entice appetite, if necessary. Health waiver.
