Adopter should call to schedule surgery after at least two weeks from recovery. Alteration surgery will be done only on animals free of any clinical symptoms.

Tx: Baytril Injection 100 mg/ml 1.5 ml IM

Pre-anesthetic: Acepromazine (2mg/ml) 0.75 cc IM, Butorphanol 10mg/ml: 0.9 cc IM,
